Characteristic form of lower coastal bluff



Character Sample Rock B
Typical Erosion Pattern



Character Sample Rock C : Sparse vegetation
(often clumped or draped over edge) does exist



Character Sample Rock D : Vertical forms
are often on descending horizontal angle



Character Sample Rock E
Rock boulders and deeply eroded rills are common



Character Sample Rock F : The clay content of the
soil tends to hold vertical forms until they break off
