INCLUSION POLICY

CODE OF CONDUCT

The City of Encinitas Parks and Recreation Department Code of Conduct is to ensure respectful and safe participation in Encinitas recreation programs and activities. Participants, as well as parents of participating minors, may be required to sign Code of Conduct forms to acknowledge program rules, goals, expected behavior and/or consequential actions to support a positive and valued learning and/or recreational experience. This Code is also to be considered and adhered to by all contracted, voluntary and other support Staff.

REFUNDS/CANCELLATION POLICY

A full refund will be issued for any program cancelled by the City. Activities are subject to change. If you cancel at least five (5) working days before the activity starts, you will receive a refund. There is a \$20 processing fee for cancellations in Day Camp, Youth Sports Camps/Clinics/Leagues and Jr. Lifeguard programs (per child, per session). No refunds after program start date in all programs. Transfers are permitted within same activity (Day Camp week to another Day Camp week), if requested at least five (5) working days before activity starts. There is a \$20 processing fee for transfers. Refunds are not issued for inclement weather. Check refunds take 2-3 weeks to process. Credits are not issued for future programs.
