



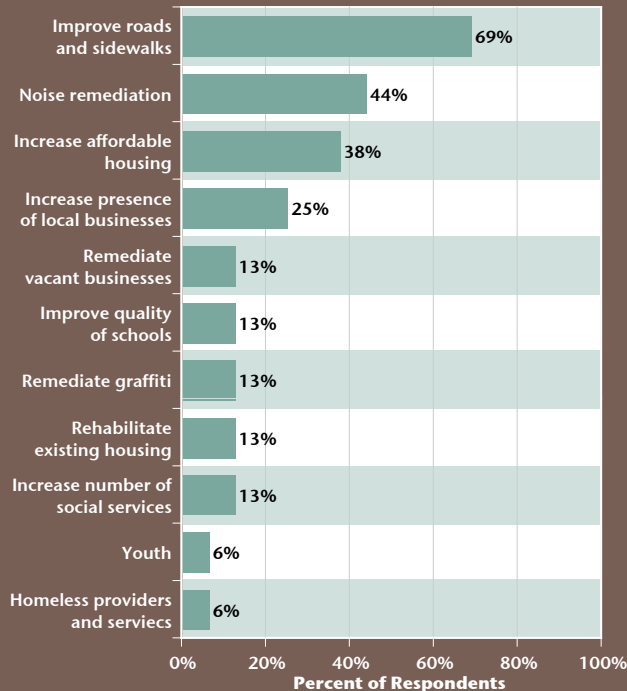
# Encinitas Residents and Their Community

## What should CDBG be used for in Encinitas?

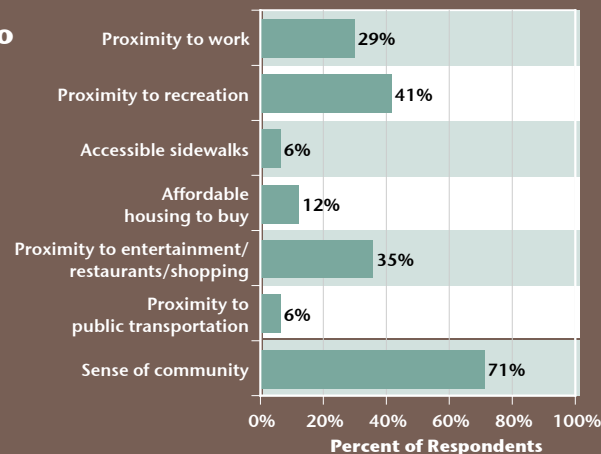
*The top three concerns of Encinitas residents were:*

- Less traffic

- Rezoning
- Community character workshops
- Maintain rural portions of the City
- Be strategic about improving older neighborhoods
- Increase City public transit opportunities

## What would you change about your current housing situation?

- Live closer to work
- Better access to Encinitas amenities
- More on-street parking
- Greater walkability
- Less traffic-related noise
- Would own rather than rent
- More infrastructure (sidewalks, curbs, etc.)

## What would you change about Encinitas?

- Greater autonomy for the five communities
- Support local businesses
- Power lines underground
- Slower sustainable growth
- More open space and hiking trails
- Stop high density building
- Improve walkability
- Emergency relief for homeless
- More public arts
- Be strategic about zoning
