**New Intersection to begin Automated Red Light Photo Enforcement
Effective October 12, 2005 at 12:01 a.m.**

The City of Encinitas will begin automated red light photo enforcement at the intersection of Leucadia Boulevard/Olivenhain Road and El Camino Real on October 12, 2005 at 12:01 a.m. The program's goal continues to be to reduce the number of collisions and improve road safety.

There will be a 30-day warning period. During this period, warning notices and photos will be mailed to drivers caught on camera running the red light. The Sheriff's Department will begin issuing official citations at the end of the warning period on November 12, 2005 at 12:01 a.m.

Automated red light photo enforcement cameras have been operational in Encinitas since May 10, 2004. Photo Enforced signs are posted at the major entrances to the City.
