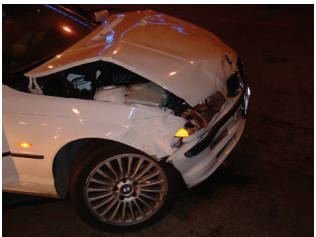

About the Program



The Abandoned Vehicle Program (AVA) helps keep Encinitas neighborhoods safe and clean by removing unwanted, abandoned or discarded vehicles.

As a free public service, the City of Encinitas Code Enforcement Division can arrange to have an inoperable vehicle removed from your property, *at no cost to you!*

This service is funded through the State of California's Abandoned Vehicle Program.

Call us and we will take care of the pick up and removal details for you. In return, you will be helping your community by creating a safer and more beautiful neighborhood for everyone to enjoy.

WHEN A VIOLATION OCCURS:

The City of Encinitas Municipal Code Chapter 14.52 allows for the removal of abandoned, wrecked, dismantled or inoperative vehicles or parts thereof to be removed as a public nuisance from streets, highways or private property.

A ten-day Notice of Violation will be provided to the registered owner prior to vehicle removal. The owner then has ten days to remove the vehicle from violation status by either disposing of the vehicle, by enclosing the vehicle within a building out of public view, or by restoring the vehicle to an operable condition and parking it legally according to City code regulations.

Removed vehicles are sent to a wrecking yard to be dismantled & destroyed.



HOW YOU CAN HELP:

- Maintain your vehicles in proper operating condition with inflated tires.
- Vehicles must be able to be driven safely on a roadway.
- Do not leave a vehicle parked on a public street in the same place for more than 72 hrs.
- Do not store junk, trash or debris in or around the vehicle.
