# ENVIRONMENTAL ART EXHIBIT

**Exhibit:** Look at everyday objects, found items and reused or recycled materials in a new way through this juried exhibit at the Encinitas Library. Presented by the City of Encinitas Commission for the Arts.

**Dates:** Earth Day, April 22 thru Environment Day, June 6, 2010. **Theme:** Recycle, Reclaim, Repurpose.

**Environmental Art Definition:** Submitted work may be reasonably considered “environmental art” if it is entirely, or primarily, composed of at least 85% material(s) that would otherwise have been disposed of in waste streams. This can include 2 or 3-dimensional artwork as well as functional items that fall into the realm of industrial design or wearable art.

1. Mixed Media—Wall Hanging (2-D)
2. Mixed Media—Free Standing (3-D)
3. Function—Waste Materials into a Working Invention
4. Fashion—Wearable Art

**Opening Reception:** Awards will be announced at the Opening Reception for the artists and the public, to be held on Saturday, April 24, 2010 from 5:00 –8:00 PM in the Community Room of the Encinitas Library. This event will also include the Opening Celebration for Green Spring Encinitas—more details to come. All are welcome to attend.

**Submitting Your Application:** You may submit up to **3** artworks for consideration, only.

**Submitting your Image:** Complete and send the attached Artwork Entry form. For adequate consideration, please submit quality photographs of your artwork (digital photo's are recommended). A written description of your artwork, the process, or your concept of environmental art, is requested. Please submit one (1) to three (3) photo's per artwork. Image files should be sent in jpg format via email, by hard copy, or on CD.

Please use the following naming convention for your digital images: **artist name-title.jpg**

**Limitations:** Applications will be accepted by \*artists who are age 16 and older. Consideration will be given to artworks of all types and sizes. Jewelry and small 3-D work will be exhibited in plexi cases located in the lobby of the Encinitas Library. Large work is allowed—if you require space for a large-scale piece or have special installation needs, please contact Jim Gilliam in advance of the deadline.

**Deadline:** The application and JPG images must be received no later than noon, Monday, April 12, 2010.

**Jurying Process:** The Selection Committee, comprised of gallery owners, visual art educators and members of the Commission for the Arts, will review all submissions and select the works for the exhibit. Applicants will be notified via email and telephone of the results immediately following the deadline.

### **Accepted Work**

- Artist's will sign a waiver of liability at the time of delivery
- Artwork must be ready to hang or display. Wall art must have wire on the back
- Artwork must remain on exhibit for the entire length of the show
- Artist retains all copyright on work
- The City of Encinitas requests permission to use submitted photographs of work for the purpose of documentation, education and publicity. Refer to the Artwork Entry form

**Delivery of Artwork:** Artwork selected for the exhibition must be delivered to the Encinitas Library on Tuesday, April 20, 2010 between the hours of 12 noon and 2:00 pm.

**Pick-up of Artwork:** Monday, June 7, between the hours of 1:00 and 3:00pm.

**Sales:** All artwork will be for sale. You may list NFS (not for sale) if you do not wish to sell your art. All sales are handled by the artist. Artists who exhibit in the Civic Art Program receive 100% of the purchase, there is no gallery commission—a service to local artists. We request that you take this into consideration when determining your pricing. Affordable art sells well in the civic galleries.

**Marketing:** The exhibit will be promoted to the San Diego media, on various websites, in email blasts, and in print materials.

**Gallery information:** The exhibit will be held at the Encinitas Library, 540 Cornish Drive, Encinitas, CA 92024 from Thursday, April 22 (Earth Day) – Sunday, June 6 (Environment Day), 2010. Library hours: Monday-Thursday, 9:30 AM-8 PM; Friday-Saturday, 9:30 AM-5 PM, Sunday, 1 -5 PM, (760)753-7376.
