

CHAPTER 6.12

OPERATIONS PERMIT: USE OF PUBLIC RECREATIONAL PROPERTY

6.12.010 Purpose. It is unlawful for any person to commence, conduct, manage, participate in or sponsor an organized, recreational activity or park event on public, recreational property without an Operations Permit: Use of Public Recreational Property. Notwithstanding the provisions of this Chapter, proposed activities shall be subject to Zoning Regulations and Coastal Development requirements, pursuant to Title 30 of this Code. (Ord. 94-06)

6.12.020 Definitions.

A. An "organized, recreational activity" is an event coordinated for a group of twenty-five (25) or more persons including, but not limited to: tennis matches, pool dances, softball games, soccer games, swim meets, or surfing contests.

B. A "park event" is an assembly, procession, march or other activity consisting of twenty-five (25) or more persons, animals, equipment, bicycles or vehicles or any combination thereof including, without limitation, weddings, concerts, and musical performances.

C. "Public, recreational property" includes public parks, buildings, pools, beaches and tennis courts, including the equipment contained therein.

6.12.030 Issuing Authority. The City Manager or designee is the issuing authority for Operations Permit: Use of Public Recreational Property. (Ord. 91-18)

6.12.040 Application. An application shall be filed no less than thirty (30) days nor more than six (6) months prior to the proposed date for commencing the proposed activity. (Ord. 91-18)

6.12.050 Regulations.

A. The organized, recreational activity or the Park event shall be conducted on public, recreational property so as not to endanger the public peace, health or safety. (Ord. 91-18)

B. In accordance with a schedule adopted from time to time by the City Council, the issuing authority shall include as a condition of the Permit a requirement to pay a use fee to reimburse the City for the cost of making the public recreational facility available to the Permittee and the costs of operating the facility for Permittee's use. (Ord. 91-18)
